I. Welcome and Introductions

Angelina Tapia (ELD Lead) introduced herself and Natalie Calderon (Learning Center Coordinator-LCC)

II. Call to Order

- Meeting was called to order by Angelina Tapia at 6:05pm

II. Information about Summative ELPAC TEST - 4 Domains

- Angelina Tapia presented the information about Summative ELPAC. Angelina Tapia Summative represented information to parents about the opportunity to visit the website and learn about the Domains of the ELPAC-she also presented information about support offered to ELL students.
- Angelina Tapia stated that Parent involvement is a critical component for students' academic growth to reclassification. She reiterated the ways that parents can become involved; joining the parent advisory committee being a major form of engagement.

III. Support and Reclassification for EL Students

- Angelina Tapia presented the reclassification process; EL students reclassified from English learning to fluent English proficient (RFEP) status. She presented the criteria used at Crescent Valley II.  
Students must take the Summative ELPAC test- given once a year.
  - a. students must earn a score of 4 overall
  - b. Students must earn a score of 3 in the writing
  - c. Student must earn 210 in the NWEA-reading (test given every 4-6 months)
  - d. Student must complete 5 English credits with “C” or better

IV. COVID-19 Response: Distance Learning

- Natalie Calderon presented information about supports offered to students during distance learning. Supervising teachers are at school one day per week. When students and teachers (staff) are at school the use of masks and physical distancing is strictly enforced.
- Natalie Calderon informed parents and students about support provided to all students during distance learning. The implementation of Google Classroom, Scan app, Digital Skills, and live core subject sessions.
